Heading into the busy summer period, we want to provide an update and clarification of the works taking place on Kenepuru Road from mid-November 2025 to 8 February 2026.

Closures until Friday 19 December 2025:

There are two closures in place on Kenepuru Road between Linkwater and the Heads:

- Between property numbers 955 and 2067, incorporating several sites.
- Near Portage Bay, approximately 1.5km prior to Portage Resort when travelling towards the Heads.

Please refer to the attached map for these closure locations.

These closures will be in place until 12pm Friday 19 December 2025 on weekdays at the below times:

- Monday to Thursday from 8am to 12pm and 12.30pm to 5pm
- Friday from 8am to 12pm and 12.30pm to 3.30pm

These closures now have coordinated midday openings between 12pm and 12.30pm. Please be assured that as long as vehicles are at their nearest closure point by 12.30pm at the latest, crews will ensure traffic does not get stuck between these closures. This applies whether vehicles are travelling from Linkwater to the Heads or from the Heads to Linkwater.

Additional opening time:

On Thursday 4 December 2025, from 2pm to 4pm a community drop-in session will be held at Portage Resort. This will be an opportunity to discuss work in the Kenepuru with members of the Marlborough Roads Recovery Team. From 12pm on Thursday 4 December there will be no construction closures in place on Kenepuru Road to allow people to attend this drop-in session. Construction closures on Kenepuru Road will recommence on Friday 5 December at 8am.

Prearranged school traffic will continue to be given access until the end of the school year.

Current closures off Kenepuru Road:

- Te Mahia Road, please go to the MDC Alert for further details.
- Torea Road, please go to the MDC Alert for further details.

Work may be undertaken outside of these days and times, under stop/go traffic management with delays of up to 15 minutes.

Emergency services will always be accommodated.

To view the closure locations online, please see the **Emergency Management Public Information Map**.

Shutdown period:

There will be no work on site from 12pm Friday 19 December 2025 until Sunday 11 January 2026 as crews take a break over the Christmas period. During this time, unattended traffic management may be in place, with minor delays.

Please note the Marlborough Roads Recovery Team office will be closed from 12pm Friday 19 December 2025 until Sunday 4 January 2026. If you have any urgent traffic management or roading concerns, please phone the on-call Marlborough Roads Recovery team member on 0800 213 213.

Work recommencement in 2026:

All construction recommencing in the Kenepuru from Monday 12 January 2026 will be under stop/go traffic management, with delays up to 15 minutes.

There will be no construction closures in place for the Kenepuru Marlborough Roads Recovery sites earlier than Monday 9 February 2026.

All work is subject to weather and other unforeseen circumstances. In the event of unsuitable conditions, work will be rescheduled to the next suitable workday, and an Antenno sent.


